

Associate of Arts & Sciences Pre-Teacher Education



PURPOSE: The Associate of Arts & Sciences degree program are designed for students who plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to complete a baccalaureate degree program.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS: Entry into the program requires the satisfactory completion of four (4) units of high school English, two (2) units of high school algebra, one (1) unit of geometry, one (1) unit of laboratory science, and one (1) unit of social science or their equivalent. Deficiencies in these areas may be corrected by completing the appropriate developmental studies courses. Students are encouraged to check the mathematics requirements of the four-year college or university to which you plan to transfer to determine the appropriate courses to be taken at MECC, as well as to determine the transferability of electives.
